January 21 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing an Introduction: structure, content • Discussion on selected participants' Introduction. • Cohesion, linking words
February 04 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing a Discussion: structure, content • Discussion on selected participants' Discussion.
February 18 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completing a draft manuscript • Communication with the editor / reviewers

Participants are asked to prepare drafts of individual parts of their potential research paper, to be sent 2 day before the next meeting.
